Cradled by the water of the Indian Ocean, after this experience will surely see sunsets with different eyes.

Local nibbles such as samosas and bajias are offered. If you would like drinks, feel free to bring your own or request the captain ahead of time.

- time: 4:30pm - 7:00pm approx

- cost: Ksh 1,500 per person (minimum fee Ksh 6,000)

• SUNSET + DINNER on the dhow

The ultimate treat.

Ideal for spending half a day chilling and eventually enjoy a delicious dinner under a starry sky.

Sailing at sunset is already the quintessential relaxing experience where your eyes are filled with beauty and the colours nature has to offer. Once the sun goes down the atmosphere changes completely.

Cradled by the sea after dark, you may enjoy a breathtaking starry sky or be seduced by the moon.

The dinner preparation is also something you won't forget. The ability of the crew and the taste of the dishes will leave you speechless.

This meal usually includes: grilled fresh fish, delicious fresh salad or coconut vegetable sauce, grilled chapatis, coconut rice cooked in the traditional way, plenty of fresh seasonal fruit and water.

If you would like drinks, feel free to bring your own or request the captain ahead of time.

- time: 4:30pm - 9:00pm approx

- cost: Ksh 3,500 per person (minimum fee Ksh 13,000)

• SAILING on dhow in the Lamu channel

A very pleasant and relaxing experience tailored to the clients' needs.

You will be sailing through Lamu channels surrounded by mangroves where you can watch the birds or decide to dive into the water for a refreshing splash. You can also take this opportunity to sunbathe on board or going for a walk on the beach.

- time: 3 hours approximately

- leaving time according to the clients' request, availability and tide

- cost: Ksh 9,000 total (1-4 people)

• SAILING on dhow + EXPLORING Takwa Ruins + FISHING experience + LUNCH on the beach

An unmissable blend of relaxation, adventure, culture, history and delight.

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- time: 6 hours approximately

- leaving time: according to the tide.

- cost: Ksh 3,000 per person (minimum fee Ksh 12,000)

• MANDATOTO island + snorkeling + LUNCH on the dhow

Another classic of Lamu experience.

Mandatoto ("small Manda" in Swahili language) is a deserted strip of sand in the middle of the ocean. Only a few fishermen's huts can sometimes be spotted among the spontaneous vegetation. You will feel like a Robinson Crusoe for the day.

This trip will give you a chance to sunbathe while sailing towards Mandatoto, snorkel among the coral reef and walk on the deserted beach where seagulls and other native birds still find shelter. While you enjoy this paradise, a delicious fresh lunch is being prepared on the boat.

This meal usually includes: grilled fresh fish, delicious salad or coconut vegetable sauce, grilled chapatis, coconut rice cooked in the traditional way, plenty of fresh seasonal fruit and water.

- time: 9:00am - 4:00pm

- cost: Ksh 3,500 per person (minimum fee Ksh 15,000)

• KIPUNGANI + swimming + LUNCH on the dhow
